

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 89-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 91-23

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND (6004)

WHEREAS, additional funding is required to pay for sludge removal expenses through the end of the year to allow both treatment plants to retain low volumes of stored sludge; and

WHEREAS, currently, the City has approximately 385,000 gallons of sludge in storage leaving 615,000 gallons available in the event it cannot be applied due to weather or mechanical failure; and

WHEREAS, maintaining lower volumes of stored sludge helps reduce the odor emitted in the surrounding area; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor for the Water Pollution Control Fund (6004) in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) to cover sludge removal costs for the remainder of the year.

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Water Pollution Control Fund (6004) in expense account 6004.6750.52005 (Sludge Hauling) in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) to cover sludge removal costs for the remainder of the year.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
