PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 95-23

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is planning to resurface the road, replace sections of curb and add sidewalks, and re-stripe on and along South Broad Street from approximately the railroad tracks / South Columbus Street South to the City Corporation limit, and if awarded, it is anticipated that the project will be constructed during the 2024 construction season; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") Program; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements or contracts necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance for the anticipated improvement project.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
