

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 96-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 97-23

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE FIRE IMPACT FUND (3022) AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Lancaster City Council approved the purchase of real property in Permanent Ordinance 16-23 for the construction of a new engine house; and

WHEREAS, the Lancaster Fire Department would like to fund that purchase with Fire Impact fees that have not yet been appropriated; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor for the Fire Impact Fund (3022) in the amount of Eighty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$86,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the Fire Impact Fund (3022) in the expense account 3022.9270.56000 (Land Purchase) in the amount of Eighty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$86,000.00) to purchase real property for the construction of a new engine house.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City and for the further reason that this resolution must be enacted to purchase this desirable property immediately for the construction of a new engine house; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
