

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 119-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE GENERAL FUND (1001), AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, City Council passed Permanent Resolution 58-23 on June 12, 2023, to demolish and reconstruct the City owned parking lot located on Chestnut Street; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are necessary to pay for unforeseen expenses discovered during construction, which included filling an abandoned cistern, as well as the relocation of an existing storm sewer and a sanitary sewer lateral; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Engineering currently has a purchase order in place, but does not have enough funds to pay an invoice they have in hand, without additional monies; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Ninety-Nine Cents (\$17,961.99) in the General Fund (1001).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Ninety-Nine Cents (\$17,961.99) in the expense account 1001.1470.56020 (Improvements-Non Building).

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City and for the further reason that this resolution needs to be enacted to pay the invoice currently in hand; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
