PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 110-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE INDEPENDENCE BOULEVARD AND EAST MAIN STREET CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS, City Council passed Permanent Resolution 73-23 on July 17, 2023, authorizing the Service-Safety Director to advertise for bids for this project; and

WHEREAS, City Council passed Permanent Resolution 79-23 on August 14, 2023, authorizing the Service-Safety Director to enter into an engineering agreement for construction and administration services for this project; and

WHEREAS, there are three (3) existing culverts located under Independence Boulevard and East Main Street which were determined to be undersized when they were evaluated according to the City's current Design Standards; and

WHEREAS, due to being undersized, these culverts contribute to localized flooding during large rain events; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared plans to replace these culverts with larger diameter pipes which will mitigate flooding concerns; and

WHEREAS, the City has advertised for bids for this project and will need to enter into a contract with the successful bidder to have the project constructed; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the construction of The Independence Boulevard and E. Main Street Culvert Replacement Projects in an amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
