

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 126-23

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 121-23

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE .45 POLICE & FIRE LEVY 2021 FUND (2051) AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Lancaster Police Department has an overtime budget need for the remainder of 2023 to pay for officer overtime worked and union contract comp-time payout obligations as of the end of November through the end of December; and

WHEREAS, employer Medicare Tax will need to be appropriated to cover the additional overtime payments; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$126,813.00) in the .45 Police & Fire Levy 2021 Fund (2051).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the following expense accounts:

2051-3250-51003, Overtime-Police	\$125,000.00
2051-3250-51053, Medicare-Police	\$ 1,813.00
Total	\$126,813.00

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City and for the further reason that this resolution needs to be enacted due to a payroll deficit; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
