PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 122-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO APPLY FOR A FEDERAL GRANT TO HELP FUND AN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ON EAST MAIN STREET

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for a Federal grant money to help fund an improvement project on East Main Street from approximately Ewing Street East to approximately the existing signal at Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated improvement project will include widening the road just east of Ewing Street to east of Baldwin, adding sidewalks along both sides of the road, upgrading the pedestrian crossings as needed, and re-striping the road; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, it is anticipated that the project will be constructed during the 2027 construction season; and

WHEREAS, the balance of the funding for this project will come from the unencumbered balance in the General Fund (1001), which will be appropriated through an additional resolution with to come before City Council at a later date; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster is hereby authorized to apply for a Federal grant to help fund an improvement project on East Main Street from approximately Ewing Street East to approximately the existing signal at Lancaster-Fairfield Community Action.

SECTION 2. That the anticipated improvement project will include widening the road just east of Ewing Street to east of Baldwin, adding sidewalks along both sides of the road, upgrading the pedestrian crossings as needed, and re-striping the road.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor is authorized to act on behalf of the City with respect to the request, including signing any and all documentation necessary for the award of grant funds.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
