PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 131-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY FEDERAL LOCAL LET PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE EAST SIXTH AVENUE BRIDGE OVER FETTERS RUN REPLACEMENT PROJECT, PID 120475 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO DESIGN/PRECONSTRUCTION SERVICES CONTRACTS WITH VARIOUS CONSULTANTS

WHEREAS, the project known as the East Sixth Avenue Bridge Over Fetters Run Replacement Project, PID 120475 has been awarded grant funding; and

WHEREAS, Federal grant funding will pay for 95% of construction costs up to a maximum of One Million Nine Hundred Forty-One Thousand Three Hundred Seven Dollars (\$1,941,307.00); and

WHEREAS, through an ODOT task order up to a maximum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) of design expenses will also be funded; and

WHEREAS, up to an additional Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) will also be needed to pay for design/preconstruction services; and

WHEREAS, the legislation authorizing the Service-Safety Director to go out for bid and award the project will be through a separate resolution to come before City Council at a later date as it is anticipated that the project will be bid in 2026 or 2027; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into an LPA Federal Local LET Project Agreement with ODOT for the East Sixth Avenue Bridge over Fetters Run Replacement Project.

SECTION 2. That the Service Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into design/preconstruction services contracts in an amount not to exceed Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) with various consultants.

SECTION 3. That Federal grant funding will pay for 95% of construction costs up to a maximum of One Million Nine Hundred Forty-One Thousand Three Hundred Seven Dollars (\$1,941,307.00).

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
