PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 12-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE SOLIDS HANDLING FACILITY

WHEREAS the City of Lancaster owns a solids handling facility that operates under contract with Agrisludge; and

WHEREAS the facility was put into operation in 1998 and has now reached the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS the City wishes to proceed with design for replacement of the facility and apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan in 2024 to finance said replacement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a consulting engineering agreement not to exceed Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000.00) for design and bidding services for the Solids Handling Facility Replacement Project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
