PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 21-24

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO SETTLE
A CLAIM FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE WITH AEP

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster owns infrastructure located at 1507 East Main Street that was damaged by AEP when they struck a natural gas main while performing excavation on September 6, 2023; and

WHEREAS, AEP is prepared to take responsibility for the damages and reimburse Lancaster Municipal Gas for all materials, equipment, and labor necessary to repair the City's property, which amounts to Four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and Twelve Cents (\$4,267.12); and

WHEREAS, in exchange for this monetary settlement, AEP is asking to the City to release and waive any future claims for the property damage described above; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the Service Safety Director is hereby authorized to execute any agreements that may be necessary to settle the property damage claim described above with AEP in exchange for reimbursement of the City's damages, totaling Four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and Twelve Cents (\$4,267.12).

SECTION 2. That payment for this claim shall be credited to the Lancaster Municipal Gas Department.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
