A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ELECTRONIC BILLING AND MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Fire Department requires an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Electronic Billing System and Management Information System (MIS) that interface for the efficient operation of the department; and

WHEREAS, the current EMS Billing/MIS agreement with Change Healthcare is in peril due to a cyber-attack that has disabled the company's operations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO,

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for competitive bids for and enter into an EMS Billing/MIS contract.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
