A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH WATER PLANT BOOSTER PUMP PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Temporary Resolution 71-24, which is pending before Council, the City of Lancaster is undertaking a construction project to install concentrate booster pumps at the South Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, engineering services are needed for construction administration, material testing, resident project representative, SCADA system programming, development of operation and maintenance manuals and training, record drawings and general consulting for the plant upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to contract with ARCADIS U.S., Inc. for these services; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a consulting engineering agreement not to exceed Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000.00) for the engineering services delineated above.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
