PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 95-24

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO APPLY FOR A .GOV DOMAIN MIGRATION GRANT, A CYBERSECURITY SOFTWARE AND SERVICES GRANT, AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the CyberOhio Program provides financial assistance to Ohio municipalities for .gov Domain Migration and Cybersecurity Software and Services deployment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster may be eligible for grant funds up to a maximum amount of Twenty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$29,500.00) to cover the cost of that migration, software deployment, and training; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the IT Department will use these grant funds to migrate the City to a new .gov domain name and purchase MFA licensing and/or training to support the City's cybersecurity initiative; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster IT Department is hereby authorized to apply for a .gov Domain Migration Grant and a Cybersecurity Software and Services Grant.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City of Lancaster and execute any and all grant agreements as required.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
