

TEMPORARY ORDINANCE NO. 36-24

PERMANENT ORDINANCE NO. 41-24

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL LANCASTER CODIFIED ORDINANCE PART ONE – ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE FIVE – ADMINISTRATIVE, CHAPTER 130 – SERVICE SAFETY BOARD OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster previously licensed private ambulance services, private police services, and paramedic services pursuant to Lancaster Codified Ordinance when those services were not publicly furnished; and

WHEREAS, since the City currently provides those services and no longer licenses private providers pursuant to Part One, Title Five, Chapter 130, it should be removed for clarity; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Part One – Administrative Code, Title Five – Administrative, Chapter 130 – Service Safety Board of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Lancaster, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That City Council hereby finds that this Ordinance was deliberated upon and passed in an open meeting in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
