

TEMPORARY ORDINANCE NO. 35-24

PERMANENT ORDINANCE NO. 40-24

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL LANCASTER CODIFIED ORDINANCE PART ONE – ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TITLE FIVE – ADMINISTRATIVE, CHAPTER 139 – PUBLIC TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster’s Public Transit Department ceased to exist as of July 1, 2024, when the Fairfield County Board of Commissioners assumed public transit operations for all of Fairfield County; and

WHEREAS, since the City is no longer operating a public transit system, Lancaster Codified Ordinances Part One, Title Five, Chapter 139 which addresses the City’s public transit board composition and transit advisory committee responsibilities, should be repealed for clarity; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Part One – Administrative Code, Title Five – Administrative, Chapter 139 – Public Transit Board of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Lancaster, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That City Council hereby finds that this Ordinance was deliberated upon and passed in an open meeting in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
