A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN ENGINEERING AGREEMENT FOR THE 2025 SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is currently conducting a multi-year evaluation of combined, sanitary, and storm sewers as a preventative maintenance measure; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified various sewers to be rehabilitated in 2025, including combined sewers on Madison Avenue and East Main Street, sanitary sewers in the Stonegate Meadows Subdivision, and storm sewers on East Sixth Avenue and possibly Eighth Avenue (the latter of which will be pending the findings from CCTV work to occur in late 2024 or early 2025); and

WHEREAS, the City has selected EMH&T to perform engineering services for this project; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a consulting engineering agreement with EMH&T not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for design and construction services.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from passage and approval by the Mayor.
