PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 136-24

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE HEALTH INSURANCE MANAGEMENT FUND (7022) AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster's health insurance carrier United Healthcare has recently made the City aware of additional unanticipated medical claims for 2024; and

WHEREAS, additional funds must be appropriated from the unencumbered balance in the 2024 budget's Health Insurance Management Fund (7022) to cover these end of year health insurance expenses; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor shall amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,00.00) in the Health Insurance Management Fund (7022).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor shall appropriate from the unencumbered balance in expense account 7022.1860.52012 (Medical Claims) in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,00.00).

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City and for the further reason that this resolution must be enacted to pay additional health insurance expenses currently due for City employees; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
