A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CITY HALL RENOVATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the design professionals at Schooley Caldwell have provided a detailed scope of work and estimate for the planned exterior restoration of Lancaster's City Hall, known as the City Hall Renovation Project, which is on the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, City administration is working with the City Auditor and Finance Committee to secure financing that will allow renovations to begin later this year; and

WHEREAS, this project will not be bid, nor will a contract be executed, until those funds are in hand; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the City Hall Renovation Project in an amount not to exceed Six Million Six Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$6,636,438.39) once financing for the project is secured and those funds are received by the City.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
