A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO APPLY FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION TO FUND THE REESE AVENUE AND WEST HUBERT AVENUE REHABILITATION PROJECT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Engineer is planning to complete an improvement project on Reese Avenue and West Hubert Avenue from Broad Street to Boving Road which will include rehabilitating the existing asphalt pavement by milling down the existing asphalt and placing new asphalt; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") currently has grant funds available for such an improvement project, and the deadline to apply for those funds is November 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, approximately 25% in local match funds will be required for this project and those will be paid out of the 2009.7500.52047 (Matching & Contract Labor) account in the 3 Mil Street Improv Levy Fund (2009); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to apply for OPWC grant funds to finance the Reese Avenue and West Hubert Avenue Rehabilitation Project and to execute any documents necessary for the award and receipt of those funds.

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City and for the further reason that approval is needed in order to meet the grant deadline of November 7th; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
