PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 109-25

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE FREDERICK STREET SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Frederick Street Sewer Separation Project is a mandated project per the Schedule of Compliance on the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") Permit with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("OEPA"); and

WHEREAS, the project involves the construction of new storm sewers in Frederick Street, between Mt. Pleasant Avenue and Oakwood Avenue, to separate out existing catch basins which currently flow into a combined sewer and contribute to combined sewer overflows into Feters Run during rain events; and


WHEREAS, the current tentative schedule is to publicly advertise the project in late January 2026 and complete construction by the fall of 2026; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the Frederick Street Sewer Separation Project to satisfy the City's NPDES Permit with OEPA.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
