PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 103-25

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT KNOWN AS THE ARBOR VALLEY DRIVE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO HIRE A CONSULTANT TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Lancaster Department of Transportation and City Engineer are currently in the planning stages of a project known as the Arbor Valley Drive Improvement Program which will include road improvements, repaving, replacing curbs, drainage improvements and walkway improvements on the segment of Arbor Valley Drive from Fair Avenue to State Route 37; and

WHEREAS, this construction project is expected to cost approximately Three Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,400,000.00) and will be funded with Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") grant funds, funds encumbered in the 2009, 3014, 3016, and 6019 Fund Accounts, as well as funds contributed by Lancaster City Schools; and

WHEREAS, inspection services are also required to ensure that this paving project is delivered to the City Engineer's standards which will require contracting with a consultant for these services; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract for construction on the project known as the Arbor Valley Drive Improvement Program in an amount not to exceed Three Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,400,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the Service-Safety Director is also hereby authorized to enter into a contract with a consultant for construction inspection services.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
