PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 8-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LANCASTER TO PARTICIPATE
IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster is a municipal corporation and political subdivision
of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act, codified in Ohio Revised Code §
125.04, provides the opportunity for Ohio political subdivisions to participate in contracts
negotiated by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing
Program for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment, and certain other materials; now,
therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF
OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and his designee are hereby authorized in the name of
the City of Lancaster, Ohio, to participate in state contracts which the Department of
Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program have negotiated for the purchase of
supplies, services, equipment, and certain other materials pursuant to Ohio Revised Code § 125.04.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and his designee are hereby authorized to agree in the
name of the City of Lancaster, Ohio, to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the
Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program prescribes. Such terms
and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs
which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of contract participation by the
City of Lancaster, Ohio. Further, that the Mayor and his designee do hereby agree to be bound by
all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or
make contract disclosures to non-members for the purpose of avoiding the requirements
established by Ohio Revised Code § 125.04.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor and his designee are hereby authorized to agree in the
name of the City of Lancaster, Ohio, to directly pay the vendor, under each state contract in which
it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Mayor and his designee do
hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.


SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the
earliest period allowed by law.




