PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE AND DECREASE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND (1001) TO COVER A UNIFORM ALLOWANCE FOR A RECENT PROMOTION WITHIN THE LANCASTER FIRE DEPARTMENT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a recent, unplanned promotion within the Lancaster Fire Department (LFD) necessitates the issuance of a uniform allowance as per LFD's Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the funds needed to cover this uniform allowance were not appropriated in the 1001.3500.51054 (Uniform Allowance – Fire) account as part of the 2026 budget and must be transferred from another account; and

WHEREAS, a transfer of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00) from 1001.3500.54009 (Medical/physicals/drugs - Fire) to 1001.3500.51054 (Uniform Allowance - Fire) will ensure the needed funds are available to cover the uniform allowance; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster shall Auditor complete an appropriation decrease and increase for the following accounts:

DECREASE:

1001.3500.54009, Medical/physicals/drugs – Fire \$4,800.00

INCREASE:

1001.3500.51054, Uniform Allowance - Fire \$4,800.00

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City and for the further reason that funds must be transferred promptly to cover the payout of the uniform allowance as required by the IAFF collective bargaining agreement; wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
