PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 4-13

A RESOLUTION TO SET THE 2013 REVENUE AND APPROPRIATION BUDGET FOR THE IMPROVEMENT FUND (317)

WHEREAS, this legislation piece is to establish a beginning of the year revenue and expense budget for the Improvement Fund;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, STATE OF OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Other Sources with the County Auditor in the Improvement Fund (317) in the amount of Three Million Two Hundred Four Thousand One Hundred Fifty Seven Dollars and Eighty Seven Cents (\$3,204,157.87).

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor in the Improvement Fund (317) in the amount of Five Million Six Hundred Three Thousand Two Hundred Three Dollars and Thirty Nine Cents (\$5,603,203.39).
