PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 81-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO CHANGE ORDER #1 FOR THE FOREST ROSE SEWER SEPARATION CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster entered into a contract for the construction of the Forest Rose Sewer Separation project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lancaster, authorized the paving of Mulberry Street from Forest Rose to Columbus Street as an addition to the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor uncovered an unknown fire cistern that required the re-routing the storm sewer and replacement of the sanitary sewer on Mulberry Street; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Water requested the contract remove a water line on Forest Rose Avenue; and

WHEREAS; the Contractor has filed Notice of Claims for the work in accordance with the contract documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Lancaster, State of Ohio, that

SECTION 1: The Service-Safety Director is authorized to enter into Change Order #1 in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Dollars (\$165,000.00) for the Forest Rose Sewer Separation Project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
