A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A GRANT, APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE, AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF OTHER SOURCES WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR, AND INCREASE RECEIPTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT FUND 317

WHEREAS, the City made application for a grant from the Fairfield County Foundation for funds to help complete the bike trail and a memorial garden for Drew Fuller at Thomas Ewing Junior High in the amount of Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00), and;

WHEREAS, the Fairfield County Foundation reviewed and approved a grant for funds from the George & Dollie Zimpfer Fund;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance to Account 317.093.5609 (Improvement/Bike Trail) in the sum of Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00)

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriation and other Sources in the Improvement Fund (317) by Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00).

SECTION 3. That the City of Lancaster Auditor increase receipts in the 317.093.4901 (Miscellaneous Receipts) by Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00).

SECTION 4. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance the sum of by Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00) in the following expense account 317.093.5609.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
