Natural gas is a colorless, odorless gas; however, a chemical that smells like rotten eggs is added to help detect a possible leak. If you smell gas, or just think you might be smelling gas, leave the area immediately and call your local gas provider or call 911 from a neighboring home or business. Never turn switches on or off or use a flashlight or phone in the presence of the gas smell, because an electric spark could ignite the gas, causing an explosion.
