

TEMPORARY RESOLUTION NO. 107-21

PERMANENT RESOLUTION NO. 106-21

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE AND TO AMEND THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATIONS WITH THE COUNTY AUDITOR IN THE GENERAL FUND (1001)

WHEREAS, the City of Lancaster Administration and City Council wish to establish funding for the Sidewalk Repair Reimbursement Program referenced in Temporary Resolution 108-21 to reimburse property owners for the expense of sidewalk replacement necessitated by City tree roots and/or general wear and tear; and

WHEREAS, City Council passed legislation in 2016 with the same goal, but there was no funding mechanism to reimburse homeowners and therefore the program was unable to advance; and

WHEREAS, the current Sidewalk Repair Reimbursement Program includes one hundred percent reimbursement for replacement of sidewalks damaged by City tree roots, which could result in significant expense;

BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER, OHIO

SECTION 1. That the City of Lancaster Auditor amend the Certificate of Appropriations with the County Auditor for the General Fund (1001) in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to cover the cost of reimbursements to residents for sidewalk replacement as authorized by the Sidewalk Repair Reimbursement Program.

SECTION 2. That the City of Lancaster Auditor appropriate from the unencumbered balance in the General Fund (1001) in the expense account 1001.1900.52049 (Sidewalk Reimb/Payments) in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
