**FY 2012 CONSOLIDATED ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EVALUATION REPORT**  
**CITY OF LANCASTER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**  
**BLOCK GRANT ENTITLEMENT PROGRAM**

The City of Lancaster is in the process of preparing its FY 2012 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) in reference to the city's Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Program. This report is being made available for public review and comment for a period of 15 days prior to submission to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The FY 2012 CAPER covers the twelve month program year commencing September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2013.

The City of Lancaster's Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report provides a concise description of community development activities, activity accomplishments, and funds budgeted and expended during the reporting period. The report also provides an assessment of the city's performance toward meeting its affordable housing strategies. It further provides information regarding the affordable housing resources available to the city and the accomplishments and activities undertaken in support of affordable housing.

The City of Lancaster's total amount of funds available for use during the reporting period was **\$835,403.14** of which a CDBG total of **\$437,382.19** was expended. Funds expended were spent on activities which resulted in a principal benefit to an estimated 4,938 low or moderate income (LMI) households. These expenditures constitute 100 percent of all funds subject to the program benefit requirements for principal benefit to LMI persons.
