

Lancaster Solar Inspections

Applicable Codes

Passing your building and electric inspection for solar PV systems requires compliance with the *2019 Residential Code of Ohio* which can be found through the link [here](#) for residential solar PV projects.

Compliance with the *2017 Ohio Building Code* is required for commercial solar PV projects. The code can be found at this link [here](#).

Additionally, all solar PV projects must comply with the *2017 National Electrical Code* which can be found through this link [here](#). Article [690](#) specifically addresses solar PV systems, but other articles may apply depending on the type of installation.

Your Inspection

Solar PV inspections generally can be completed in *one* visit.

Residential solar inspection:

- Building inspection
- Electrical inspection

Commercial solar inspection:

- Building inspection
- Electrical inspection
- If ground-mounted, footings will also be inspected.

If power needs to be disconnected for installation, your contractor should contact South Central Power or AEP depending on your power supplier.
