This includes a resident fatality, and at least two other totaled automobiles. We have been in discussion with our city councilman Presten Ahlers, who indicated that a possible solution has been discussed with Lancaster City officials and that a modification is at least a year away. Until city officials can implement a plan, the undersigned residents are requesting that the signal pattern at the intersection be changed to be green for only one direction at a time, as detected by the current motion detector. The only cost will be the time for the engineers to re-program the signal. Depending how effective the change is, it may not be necessary to make any lane modifications in the future.
