

Memorial Pierce Sidewalk Project
FAI-CR33/MR70505 4.93/1.09 (PID 120594)

The City of Lancaster in coordination with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is planning to improve pedestrian facilities along both sides of Memorial Drive (CR-33A) from Whittier Drive to Arlington Avenue. The project also includes construction of a 5-foot concrete sidewalk on the east side of Whittier Drive and the west side of Pierce Avenue. Additional work includes the installation of curb and gutter along Memorial Drive, traffic control improvements, pedestrian pushbuttons and pedestals on three existing signals, grading, and stormwater facilities. Construction is scheduled to begin after August 2027, and right-of-way acquisition is expected to begin after January 2026.
